Occidental Archery

Occidental archery is one of the classical traditions of archery. An occidental bow is unstrung whenever it is not in use to prevent the bow from shrinking. It can be made out of yew, willow or lemonwood, and the ends of the bow are notched. The bow itself is straight when not strung. The owner may choose to put colored feathers onto the bow to indicate ownership.
