

BROADHEAD LEAGE

Starts Wednesday June 11-August 13th at 6:30 PM

Same rules for competition as before, but we are adding a marked yardage group. This group will shoot together and will be able to use range finders or a marked score card that will be a different color as well as they can shoot broadheads or field tips. They will not be mixed in with the unmarked shooters unless they allow it, since we know many groups shoot as a family or friends. This is and always has been on the honor system for competition and scoring. We as a club have grown and we support all classes of archery.

We have many archers that enjoy shooting 3D, but do not have a way to compete since they are using field tips or broadheads and a range finder. This is something new we are trying, so we shall see how this goes. The marked shooters will be competing in their own groups on the targets and will compete in their own class and amongst the unmarked archers for prizes.

We can use the help setting up Wednesday afternoon and tearing down after.
