### It's all about Targets!

#### FITA Field One Day practice Tournament at Sylvan:

Sunday, May 28, is an opportunity to shoot the FITA field format in a one-day practice tournament at Sylvan. Cost is \$10 to \$15. The following weekend, USA Archery is holding its FITA field nationals in Darrington, Wash., so at least a couple of out-of-staters will be using the Sylvan tournament as a tune-up. (Registration is open for nationals, or you can pay less and shoot the same course as a guest in the concurrent Washington state FITA field.) Bow classes for awards are limited to compound, Olympic style recurve and barebow (no compound barebow). The Sylvan practice tournament will be unmarked distances (nationals is unmarked the first day) but you can shoot it for fun with a rangefinder if you don't want to practice unmarked. For unmarked, max distance for barebow is 45 meters, and 55 meters for compound and Olympic recurve. For more info, or to preregister, contact Laurie at archer.laur@gmail.com.

#### **King of the Hill Recurve Contest**

The Recurve King of the Hill Tournament is in full swing. 19 recurve archers competed on March 25th in a double Vegas Indoor Qualification Round. The top 10 archers received ranking quiver tags. Now archers are competing in head-to-head matches to improve their rankings. Competition will continue until the End of Summer 900 Tournament in September, at which time we will crown the 2017 Recurve King (or queen) of the Hill. All recurve shooters are encouraged to join in. The cost is a 1 time fee of \$15. Unranked archers can challenge rankings 6-10 to earn a quiver tag.
