If you love being out on trails in the woods as much as you love archery (especially archery with backstops!), field archery might be the most fun sport you've ever tried. This year Sylvan is hosting the OBH state field championship June 23-24, and USA Archery is holding its national field tournament in Darrington, Washington, June 7-10. Learn the formats well in advance as well as getting tips on equipment and technique in two Saturday afternoon sessions on the beautiful Sylvan courses, April 14 and April 21. Even if you're not interested in competing, shooting on a field course is so varied and enjoyable and you can choose to shoot at closer distances than the competition distances. NOTICE OF ANNUAL DUES INCREASE......

The dues for Sylvan Archers has not increased for many years. Costs have gone up, we are in need of new equipment, updates to the roving range and have to pay for part of the new cover for the practice range.

With that being said dues will be increasing on August 1st which is our fiscal year. Everyone who renews on August 1st, 2018 and after will be paying the new rates which are as follows:

Adults: from \$80 to \$100

Juniors and Seniors: from \$50 to \$60

Family: from \$110 to \$130

We are a volunteer ran club, but we still have to pay for maintenance and upkeep and targets etc. If you want to earn points towards a discount on your membership or a free membership, you can always volunteer for the board or for other ongoing club activities. We do not require any work parties as part of our membership and therefore we need to make some changes in our dues structure.
