Sylvan Archers, I will attend the Oregon Bow Hunters annual meeting for target archery in mid-march. I'd like your input.

The NFAA is considering changing the field course. And experimental pilot program is underway this year in another state. A couple of changes include:

If I have my info right, a proposal passed the vote that would change NFAA Field from 4 arrows at 28 targets (112 arrows total) to 3 arrows at 24 targets (72 arrows total). The Fans and the Walkups are the target stations that will be eliminated. Other changes permit the archer to shoot at any target on the bale. Apparently, this will be implemented at Sectionals next year, then considered again before making it a permanent change at Nationals.

Also, let me know your thoughts on:

1. Bow styles and age divisions.
2. Cubs and youth only shooting 14, 14, 14. At the field shoot
3. Shooting 28 targets on a 3-day field shoot instead of 56 targets and 28 targets in 2 days.

Hunt Director: Represent Sylvan Archers at the annual Oregon Bow Hunters meeting and be in charge of the hunt program.

One year of volunteer work on our board qualifies for one year of free membership.
