Open Sylvan Board Positions

The following information outlines our open board positions and the requirements for each of these roles.

Nominations of officers for election will take place at the April general meeting and will remain open until the June meeting. Elections will take place at the July meeting.

President: The President shall be the chief executive officer of the corporation. He/she shall be responsible for the following:

- reside at all meetings (currently held once a month for 8 months a year)
- general and active management of the business of the club
- see that all orders and resolutions of the membership and board are carried out
- responsible for the functioning of all committees

Second Vice President: Shall be in charge of all indoor activities and shooting booth. The club currently has one indoor activity, the Sportsman Show.

Secretary: Attend all meetings of the corporation and of the Board of Governors and make a record of all their proceedings.

Field Governor: Fulfill duties as designated by the Board of Governors as well as the following:

- represent the club at the Oregon Bow Hunters annual meeting
- participate in the direction of the field archery and target archery tournaments held at Sylvan Archers
- promote field and target archery
- promote the JOAD archery program

Hunt Director: Represent Sylvan Archers at the annual Oregon Bow Hunters meeting and be in charge of the hunt program.
