Dear hunters, land managers, and outdoor recreation retailers,

As many of you know, Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) offices remain closed to the public and in-person gatherings have been limited due to transmission concerns associated with the ongoing pandemic. As such, the North Willamette Watershed District Wildlife Team is conducting public outreach for the 2022 big game draft regulation proposals through phone, email, and a virtual meeting. Attached to this email is a summary of the local draft proposals and a short summary of the survey data utilized when making big game management decisions and hunt proposals.
